

04. LINE & COLOUR DRAWING



This type of picture can be great fun to create. You can take any subject from flowers, animals or in this example faces. Just start by creating an outline face with a felt tip pen, then merge another face into the first, letting some of the lines act as part of each other - the hair of one figure could be part of the neck of another, and so on.

Make your picture as complicated as you can. The more complicated the less like faces your picture looks - almost like a puzzle, with anyone looking at the picture having to access what the various lines indicate, some of the faces can be sideways or upside down!

When you're happy with the results go over your lines neatly rounding all the places where the lines cross - this can take some time but it's worth it!

Add colour or leave the picture in black and white.
