

02.OIL PAINTING



This painting of a seated lady has been produced in oil paints, but you could use anything from water colour paints to colouring pencils to create a similar picture. Try drawing the basic lines in pencil or use the picture below.

All the colours have been blended to create the effect. The dress for instance is mostly red with yellow and orange blended in to give a highlighted effect on the knee. The blouse is the same blended yellow and light brown with a touch of light blue - you can use your own colour combinations - try blue stockings and red shoes!

The background is an abstract of blended colours with no particular shape - again all the colours blend into each other so there are no distinctive solid colours. The chair is pretty basic with an outline yellow to highlight the detail.

Don't try and put much detail into the hands, hat or face as this type of painting/drawing relies on basic lines and blended colour to create its effect.
