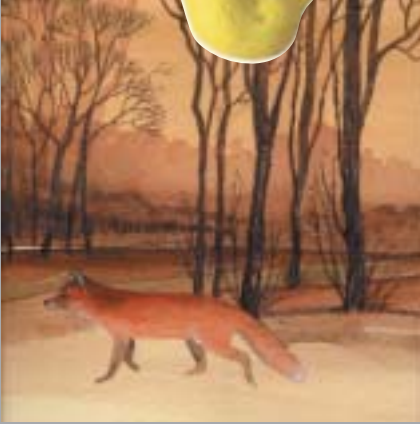


# 01. WATERCOLOUR



Try experimenting with this picture in watercolour. You can try and sketch the basic pencil strokes that make up the image by hand or you can use the outline picture below.

Cover the whole area with light yellow (don't worry about covering the fox) this light yellow acts as the background colour to the whole picture.

Next cover the whole area above the horizon (marked A) with the same strength of yellow.

The next step is to paint the tree line in the distance with a very weak brown colour down to the horizon line (marked A). Then using a strong brown, roughly paint in the trees.

Work on the fox covering the whole animal in weak orange building up the colour on it's back and head.

The next stage is to use a brown or black pencil to add the fine detail of the head and body.

The last thing to add is a white pencil - add a few white lines to the trees in the foreground and to the tip of the fox's tail, ears and nose.
