- 5 How fast can a Metro train go at top speed?

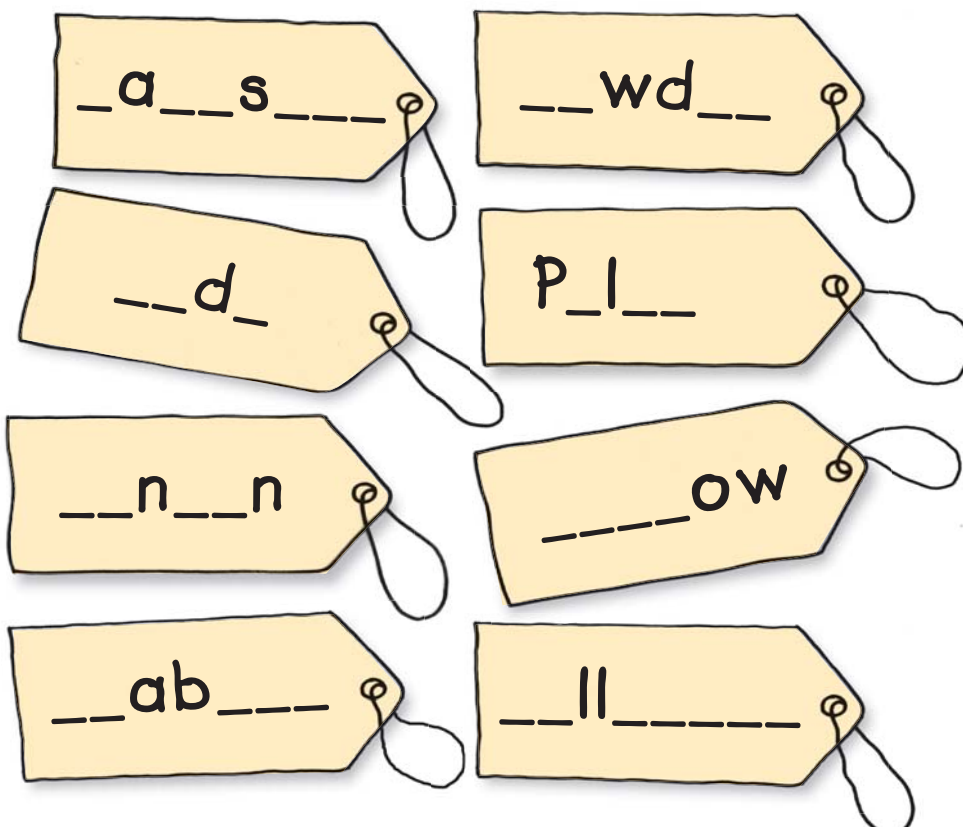
Safety Sense!
