At Metro stations we have Help Points on every platform that can be used if you are scared or want to ask about fares, Metro times or any other help you may need.

You can help to keep yourself safe by:



- Keeping your Metro fare separate, this means you don't need to get your purse or wallet out in front of others. If you are not sure how much your fare is, use the help point and ask a member of staff.



- Sitting near other people or near the driver's cab on the trains. You can speak to the driver in an emergency when they've stopped at a station.
- Standing in view of the CCTV cameras and keeping out of dark or lonely areas at stations.
