## the 5 Golden Rules

- 1** Never climb on a bridge or through a fence by the side of the railway tracks.
- 2** Never ignore railway warning signs, they are there to keep you safe.
- 3** Never play with a ball or any other toy in a railway station.
- 4** Always look out for the electricity warning signs. Never play with a kite or balloon near electric wires over the railway tracks.
- 5** Always think of other people's safety. Never throw stones at a train or put anything on the railway tracks.

These signs warn you that there is electricity in the overhead wires and on the rails that the trains run on.



**Beware of trains**

This sign warns you that trains can come at anytime.



**Passengers must not cross the line**

This sign warns you that you must never cross the railway line.

You will see this sign at some railway crossings. When the lights flash it means a train is coming.
