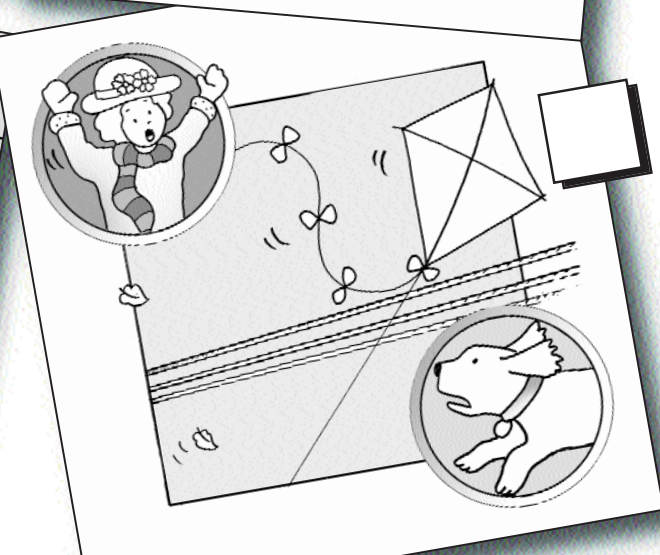
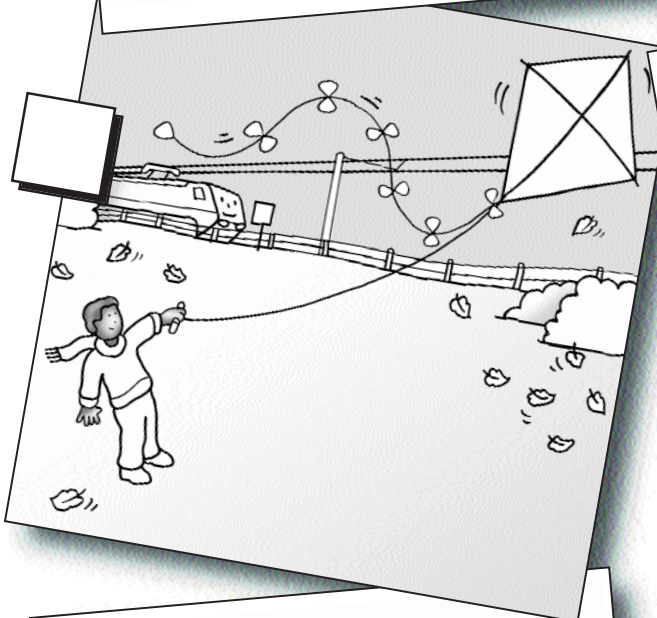
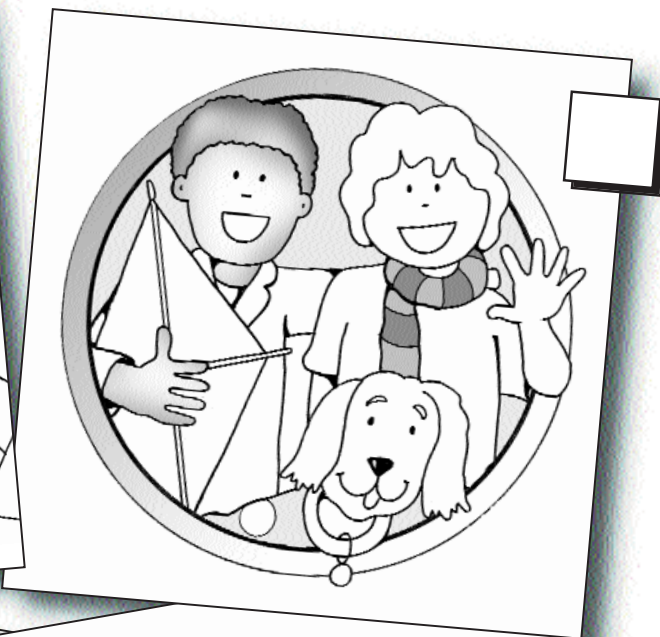
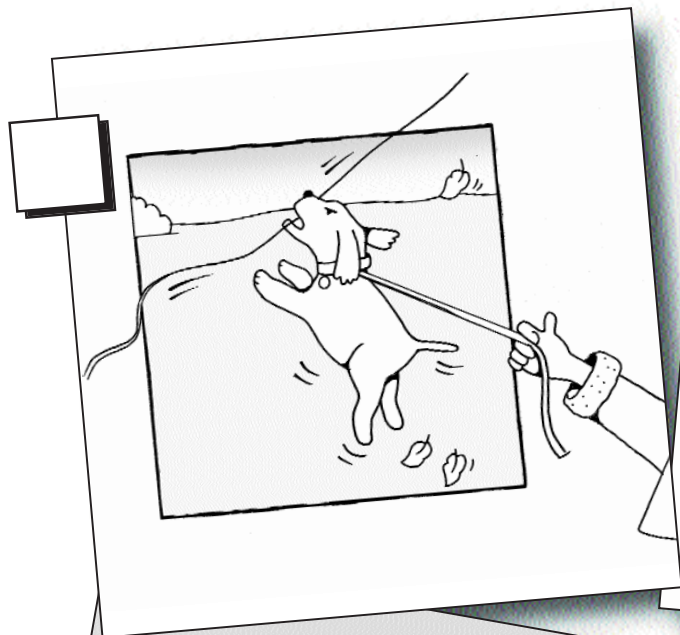


# Suzy saves the day!

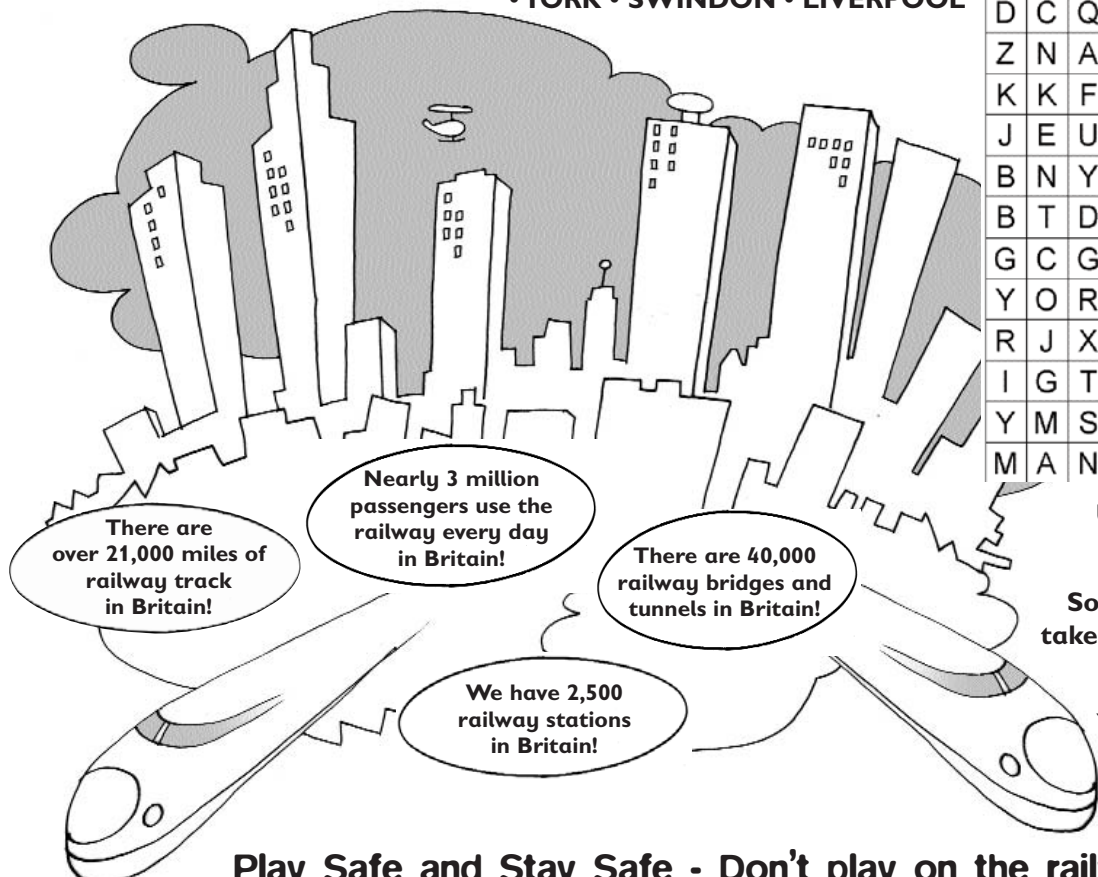
**Electricity on the railway can jump across gaps or go down the string of a kite and badly injure you.**

Using the train is a fast and easy way to travel.

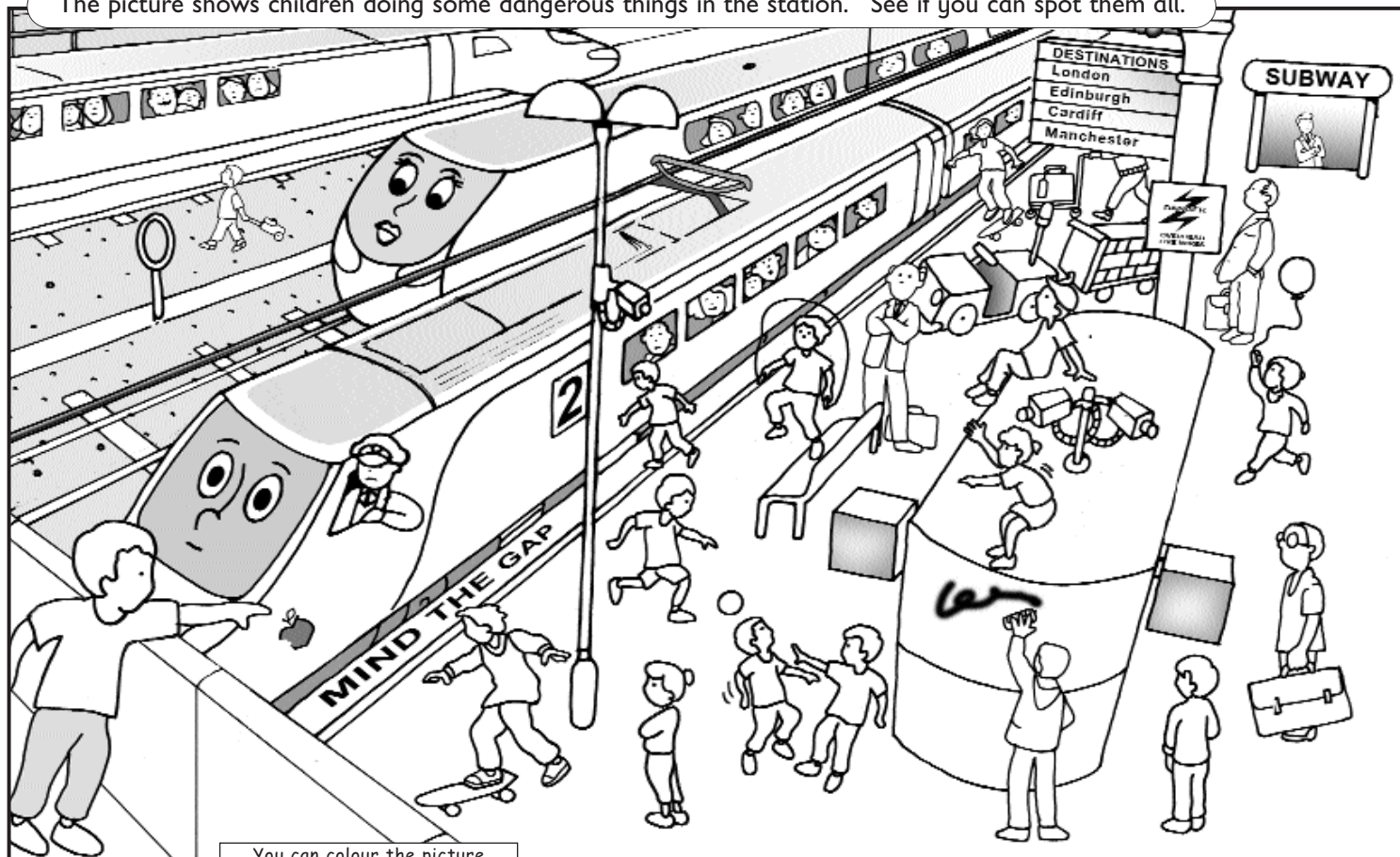
Some trains travel very fast and take a long time to stop if they have to brake in an emergency.
