# 750 volts of electricity pass through the live rail on the railway tracks.

**This rail is live 24/7.**

The live rail runs along the ground next to the normal track and because it looks like any other rail, it is sometimes known as a 'third' rail.

The power is never switched off even during holidays. The rail is always live even if there are no trains running on the track.

Step on the rail and you will get a massive electric shock.
