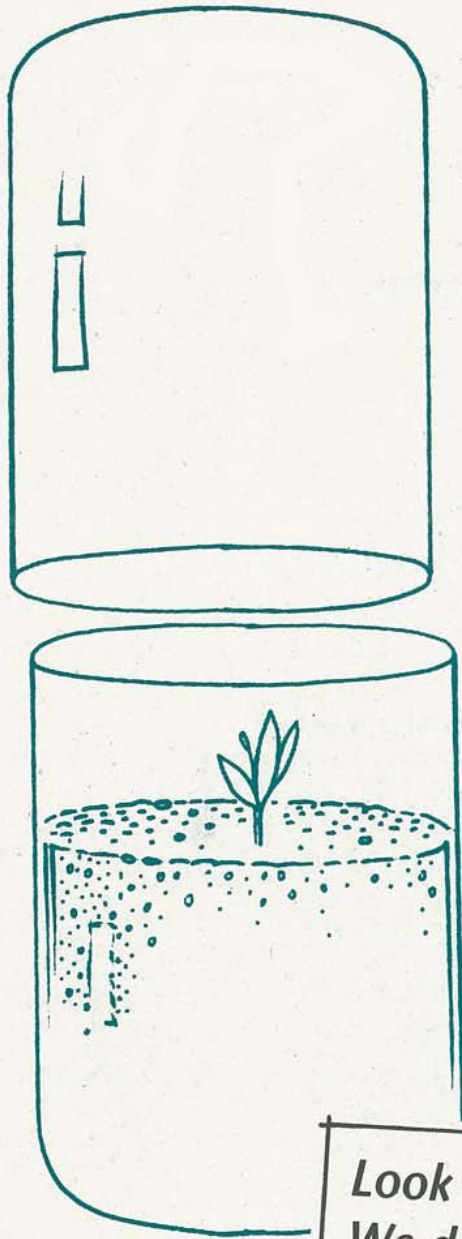


We breathe out carbon dioxide, plants take it in. Plants give off oxygen, we breathe it in at a rate of 65 litres per hour. This is one of the ways in which the environment is 'balanced' and looks after itself.



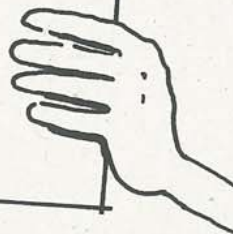
MAKING A TERRARIUM

You will have to make a sealed, clear plastic container.

1. Use two colourless plastic bottles with the tops cut off both.
2. Fill to about 2/3 one of the plastic bottle ends with good soil.
3. Plant into the soil a young plant (suggest Tradescantia) and water it well.
4. Turn the empty bottle end over the one containing the soil.
5. Seal the container with good sticky tape.

The plant will be able to survive in its own environment within the sealed container.
