## Buying a ticket

Before using Metro everyone needs to buy a ticket. There are ticket machines at the entrance of every station.

Some schools have their own ticket machine which means you don't have to queue up at home time.

There are also timetables, Metro maps and train indicator boards to tell you where the next train is going and how long you'll have to wait.

Make sure you carry your Under 16 card and keep your ticket with you at all times.

Don't throw your tickets away until you are out of the station because we have ticket inspectors checking tickets all around the stations.

If you are caught without a ticket you can be fined £10 and taken to court. Travelling without a ticket on Metro is a criminal offence.
