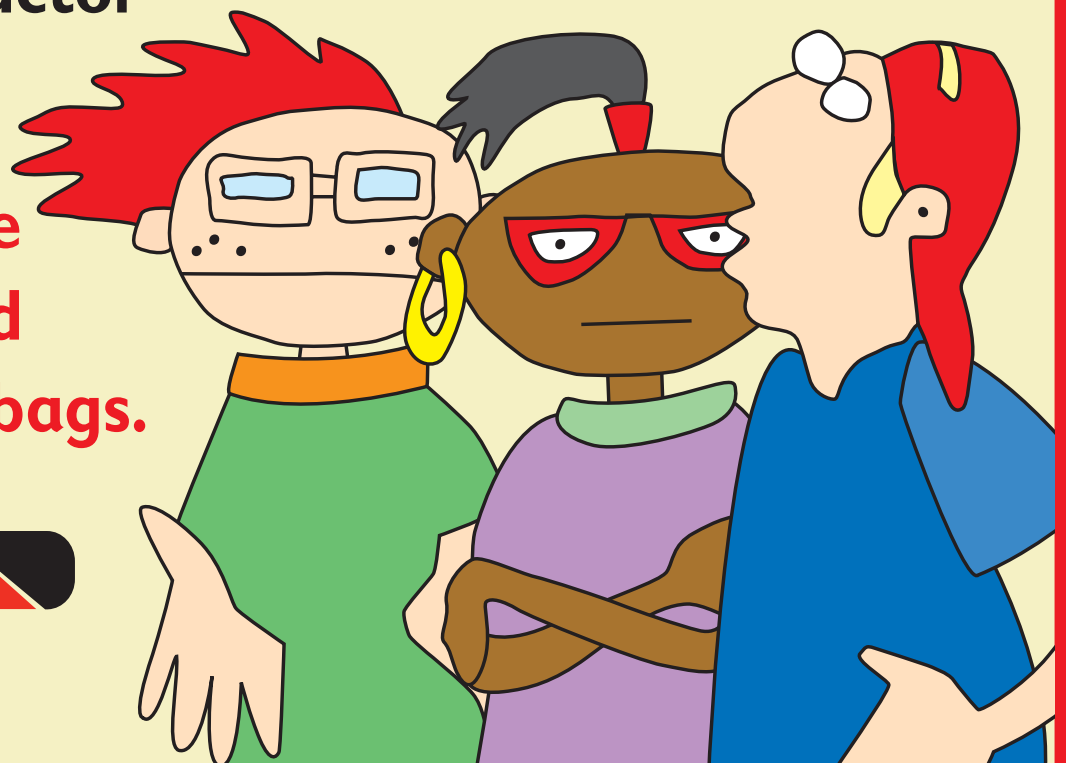


# COOL CODE

- 1** Never climb on a bridge over the railway tracks. Always stay on the right side of the railway fence.
- 2** Never take a short cut across the tracks. Always use a proper railway crossing.
- 3** Take note of overhead electricity warning signs. Remember electricity can jump across gaps.
- 4** Never throw things at trains or put anything on the railway tracks.
- 5** Don't mess around on a station platform and stay behind the safety line until the train stops.
- 6** Stay seated during a train journey or stand where you can hold on safely.
- 7** Show respect to the conductor and other passengers.
- 8** Never play with or remove emergency equipment and keep doors/aisles clear of bags.

Never ignore railway warning signs, they are there to keep you safe.



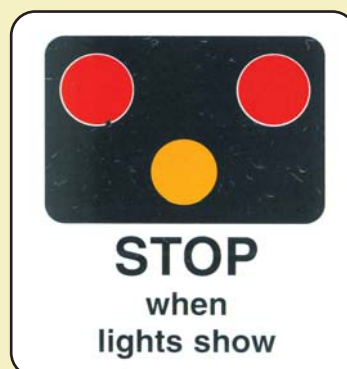
These signs warn you that there is electricity in the overhead wires and on the rails that the trains run on.



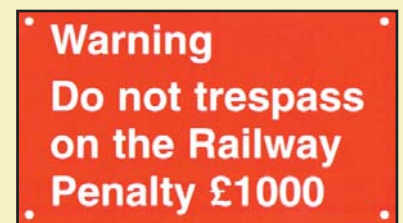
This sign warns you that trains can come at anytime.
