Misadventure verdict on teenager's death

A teenager who had appeared on TV's Popstars: The Rivals died when he was hit by a train as he walked along the railway line, an inquest heard.

The 19-year-old, who made it down to the last 120 contestants in the nationwide search for pop talent, was returning from a late-night party when he was struck by the train between Balham and Streatham stations.

Westminster Coroners Court heard how the pop star wannabe who lived in Battersea, had been walking along the tracks near Tooting Bec

Bridge with his Norwegian friend at around 5am on November 4 last year, when the accident happened.

The court heard his friend, who has since returned to Norway, told police the pair had moved out of the way of an oncoming train when the 19-year-old was struck from behind by another train travelling in the opposite direction at around 50mph.
