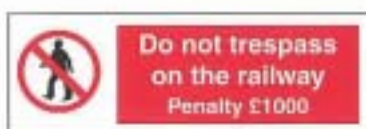


Signs are a very good way to tell people what they can and cannot do. They are easy to understand because they use symbols, different colours and very simple words.

RED SIGNS tell you things you **must not** do.



BLUE SIGNS tell you what you **must** do.

KEEP CLEAR

YELLOW SIGNS warn you there is danger nearby.



Danger
Overhead live wires
Live rails

GREEN SIGNS give you information about safety.



WHITE SIGNS give you information about things you might need.

DON'T X WHEN THE RED LIGHTS FLASH!
IT'S NOT FLASH AND IT MAKES US CROSS

Where a railway line crosses a road it is called a **level crossing**.

Level crossings have **barriers** which close when a train is coming.

Before the barriers close, a **yellow light flashes** and there is a **warning noise**.
As the train gets near, two **red lights** flash.

Never cross when the barriers are closed.

ALWAYS OBEY THE WARNING SIGNALS.
