BOAR - a male badger	SOW - a female badger
CUB - a young badger	SETT - the place where badgers live
SAND - badger setts are often in sandy soil	DIG - this is what badgers do to make their setts!
PAW - the badger's large front paws are ideal for digging	CLAW - long claws useful when digging, and for other things ...
GROOM - badgers like to scratch and groom their fur	BEDDING - they also scratch up dry plant material to make nests
NIGHT - the time when badgers are active	NOCTURNAL - a word for animals which are active at night
OWL - a nocturnal bird!	BAT - a nocturnal mammal!
FOX - the fox sometimes shares the badger's sett, and is also active at night	RABBIT - rabbits live in badger setts too, even though badgers sometimes eat them
RAT - badgers will also eat rats from time to time	VOLE - voles too are dug out from their nests and eaten by badgers
BEE - badgers love honey, and sometimes they will dig up bees' nests to get it	EARTHWORM - the main food of the badger
BARLEY - badgers don't just eat animals, they also eat roots, fruits, berries, oats, and barley	OMNIVORE - a word for animals like badgers which eat both animal and plant foods
LATRINE - a place where badgers dig small pits for their droppings
