Electra saw a little girl she knew called Alysha.




Alysha was walking with her dog called Suzy.

“Electricity in overhead wires can jump across gaps and hurt you.”**

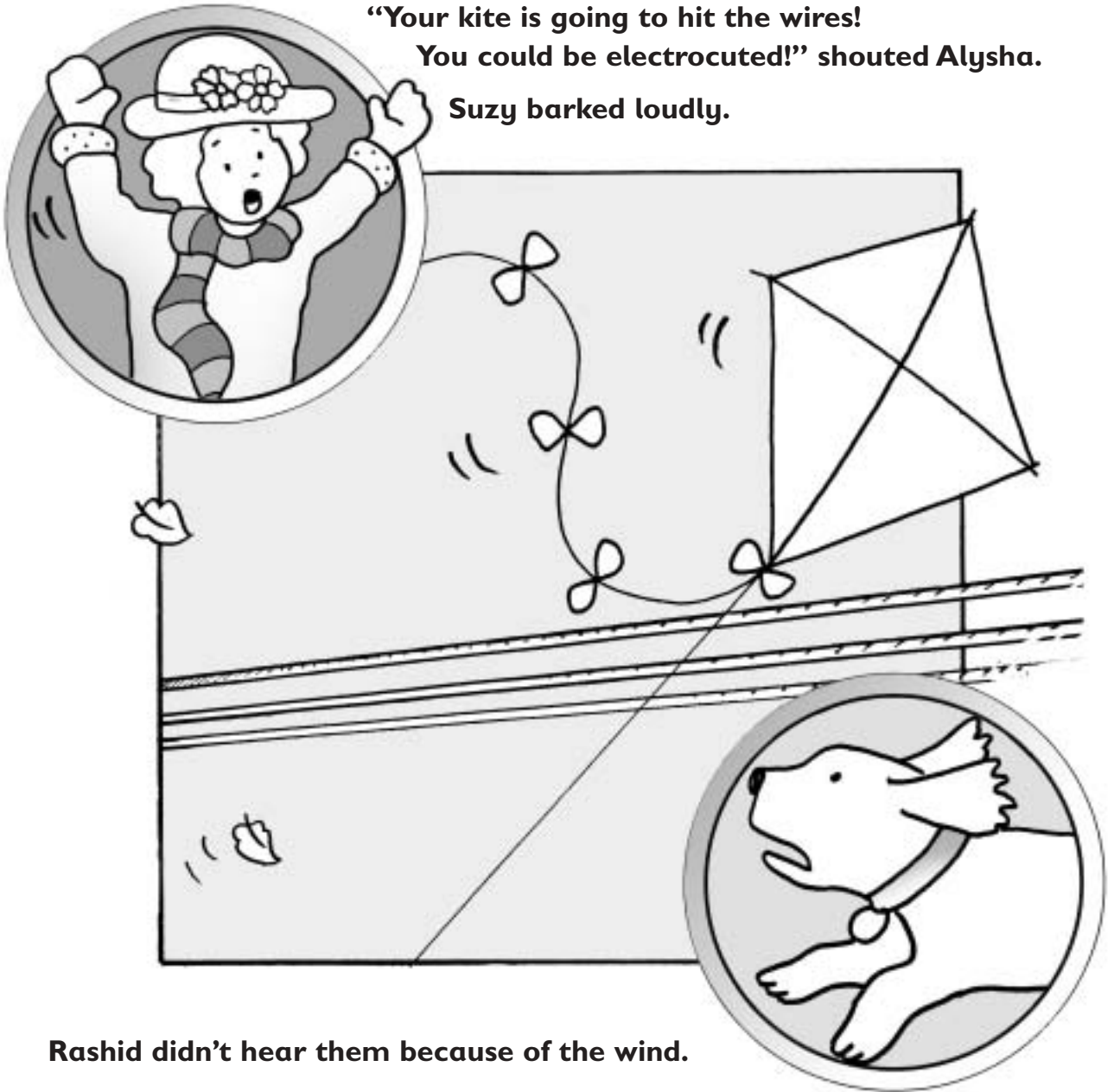


Alysha saw her friend Rashid playing with a kite near the railway line.

Alysha could see the danger!

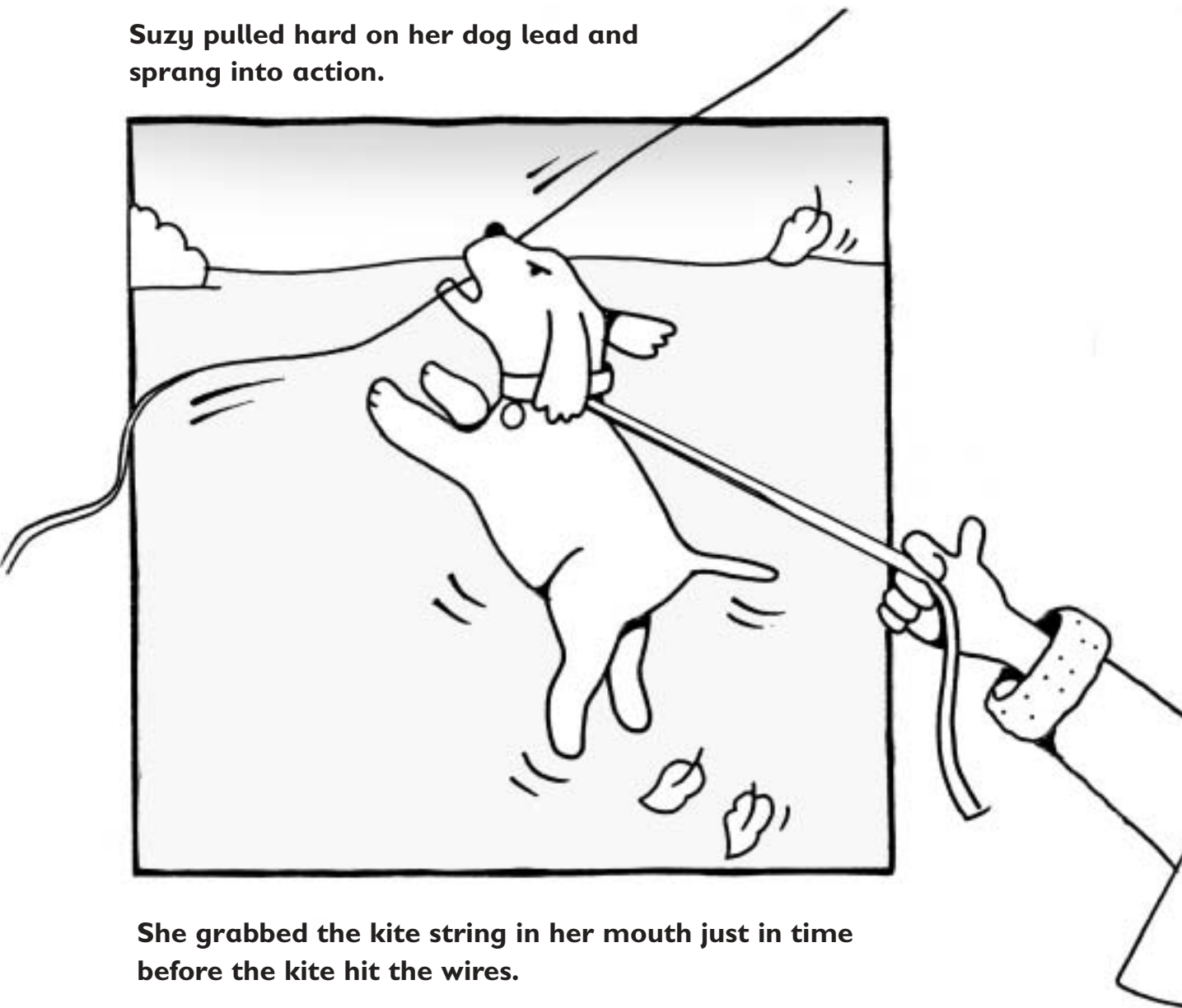
**“Your kite is going to hit the wires!
